# **To the Tug**

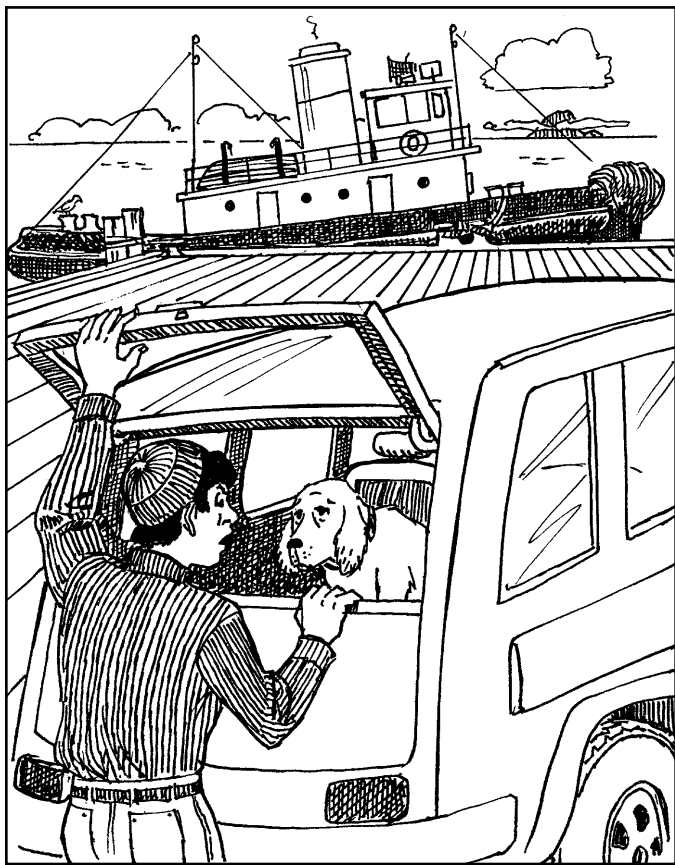
It was six. Bob was in bed. The sun was not up yet. But Bob had to get up. He had to get to his job. Bob had a job on a tug.

“Sam, you can not go on the tug,” said Bob.



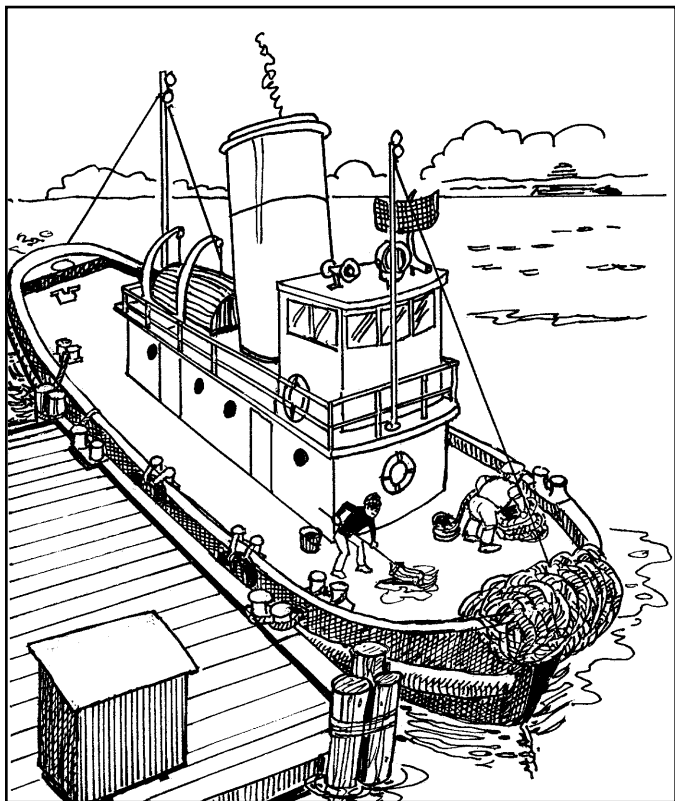
“Sit on the dock till I get back. Do not run off.”
